



HURLINGHAM RETAIL CENTRE NEARS COMPLETION

This very prominent development situated in Hurlingham and often referred to as Hurlingham Retail, is entering the final stages of its construction. Some of the benefits of the development can already be enjoyed with the completion of the road widening of William Nicol southbound, as well as the upgrade of the intersection with Republic Road. The rehabilitation of the riverbank has commenced, with the much anticipated upgraded cycle tracks to be completed in due course.

The centre will offer convenience stores, including a Pick 'n Pay with its wide range of products, a Pick 'n Pay Liquor Store, a coffee shop, cooking school and a range of service orientated line shops including optometrists, a pet food outlet, dry cleaners, day spa and hairdresser. This variety in shopping promises a one stop shopping experience for patrons.

The uniqueness of the development lies in the careful planning which includes cutting edge sustainability initiatives such as rainwater harvesting, ice storage for refrigeration and air conditioning as well as daylight harvesting through skylights.

The Hurlingham Retail Centre is expected to open in October 2010.
